

Money word problems

Grade 4 Word Problems Worksheet

1. Jack had \$10. He bought a pair of socks for \$2.30 and a pair of gloves for \$5.50. How much money did he have left?

2. A music store is having its “Black Friday” sale. The store will give \$5 off for the second item a customer purchases. Emma wants to buy a pair of headphones for \$25 and a CD for \$18.50. How much does she need to pay in total?

3. Coffee mugs cost \$2.50 each. How much do 5 coffee mugs cost?



Answers

- $\$10.00 - \$2.30 - \$5.50 = \2.20
Jack had \$2.20 left.
- $\$25.00 + \$18.50 - \$5.00 = \38.50
Emma needs to pay \$38.50.
- $\$2.50 \times 4 = \12.50
5 coffee mugs cost \$12.50.
- $\$32 \div 4 = \8
Each of his children can get \$8.
- $\$1.50 \times 20 = \30
Olivia raised \$30 for her school
 $30 \times \$30 = \900
Altogether, the grade 4 class raised \$900.
