


Metric units of weight: grams (g) and kilograms (kg)

Answers

- A tape dispenser: 780 g
- A bottle of soap: 1 kg
- A book: 550 g
- A pair of scissors: 180 g
- A glass pitcher: 6 kg
- A fridge: 80 kg
- A guitar: 3 kg
- A dumbbell: 5 kg
- A towel: 650 g

Example of objects that weigh 10 gram:

a tablespoon of butter, a small pen, a battery, a small eraser

Example of objects that weigh 10 kilograms:

a bike, a bag of flour, a car tire, a high chair, a large mirror
