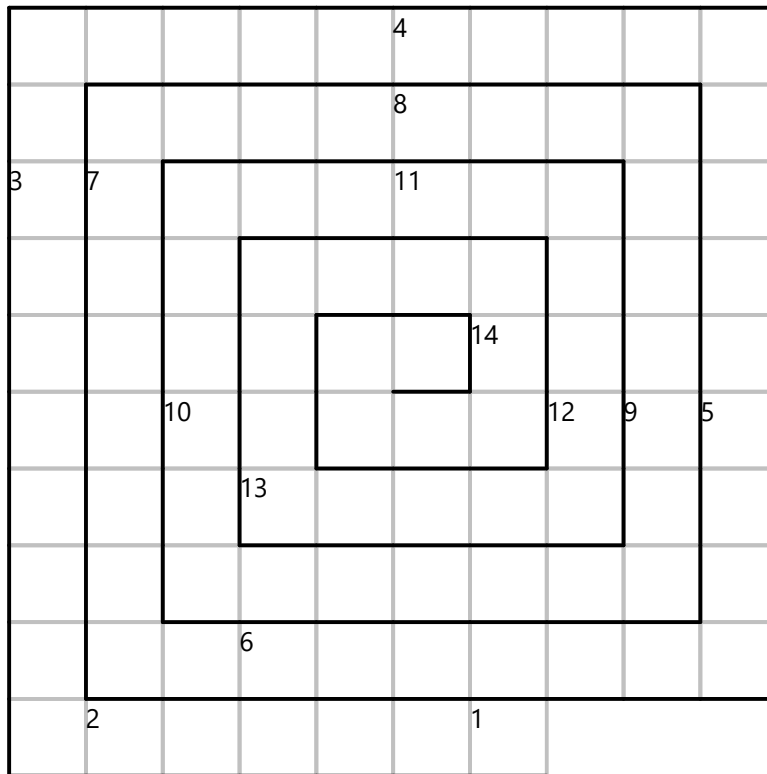


# Spiral Crossword

Solve the crossword in the spiral direction.

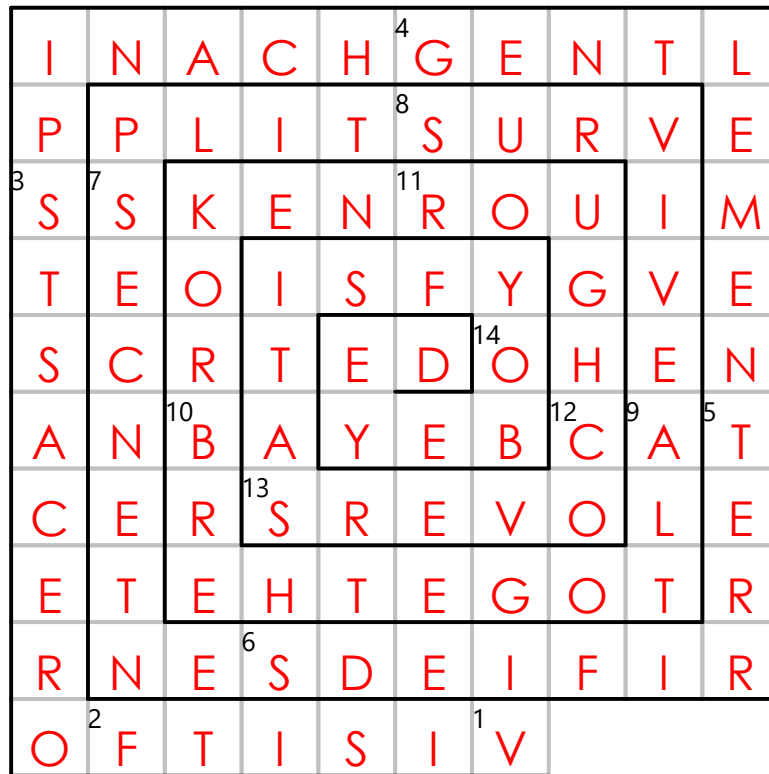
