

**Parts of Speech**  
**Plural Nouns – Change “y” to “i” and add “es”**

Some nouns end in a consonant letter and “y”. You usually change the “y” to “i” and add “es” to make these nouns plural.

Examples: country -> **countries**

library -> **libraries**

Some nouns end in a vowel letter and “y”. You usually don’t change the “y” to “i” and add “es”. You add an “s” to make these nouns plural.

Examples: donkey -> **donkeys**

monkey -> **monkeys**

Change the “y” to “i” and add “es” to make these nouns plural. Notice that these words end with a consonant and a “y”.
