4. The water was clear and blue.

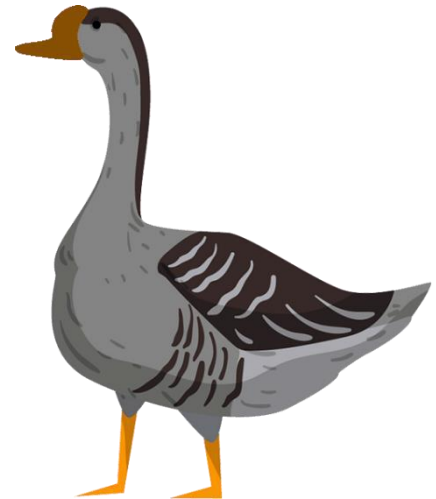
