





Counting Change

When you buy an item, you might not have the exact coins and notes for the amount it costs. However, you can pay with a larger note and get back some change.

To give change, or to check the change you are given, **count up** from the price of the item until you reach the amount the customer gave.

 <p>\$0.35 The customer gave \$1</p>	<p>Count up from the price →</p>	 <p>\$0.40 \$0.60 \$0.80 \$1.00</p>	<p>The change is these coins. The change is 65 cents.</p>
 <p>\$2.70 The customer gave \$5</p>	<p>Count up from the price →</p>	 <p>\$2.80 \$2.90 \$3.00 \$5.00</p>	<p>The change is these coins. The change is \$2.30.</p>
