

Counting Change

When you buy an item, you might not have the exact coins and notes for the amount it costs. However, you can pay with a larger note and get back some change. To give change, or to check the change you are given, <u>count up</u> from the price of the item until you reach the amount the customer gave. The change is these coins. \$0.35 Count up The change from is 65 cents. The customer gave \$1 the price \rightarrow \$0.60 \$0.80 \$1.00 \$0.40 The change is \$2.70 Count up these coins. The change is from The customer gave \$5 \$2.30. \$3.00 \$5.00 the price \rightarrow \$2.80 \$2.90
