

## **Mental Maths and Money Problems**

You can also add money amounts in your mind. Add the pounds and the pence separately.	$\pounds 1.20 + \pounds 1.50$ = $\pounds 2.70$	$\pounds 0.\underline{14} + \pounds 1.\underline{20}$ $= \pounds 1.\underline{34}$
If you have 100p, then those make a pound.	$\pounds 0.70 + \pounds 0.70$ = 140p = £1.40	$\pounds 0.99 + \pounds 0.06$ = 105p = £1.05
