## Practicing with Money

- One quarter = $\qquad$ cents.
Use ONE quarter when the money amount is between 25 and 50 cents. Example: To make 31 cents, take one quarter, one nickel, and one penny.
- Two quarters = $\qquad$ cents.
Use TWO quarters when the money amount is between 50 and 75 cents. Example: To make 62 cents, take two quarters, one dime, and two pennies.
- Three quarters $=$ $\qquad$ cents.
Use THREE quarters when the money amount is between 75 and 100 cents. Example: To make 87 cents, use three quarters, one dime, and two pennies.
- Four quarters $=100$ cents or one dollar.
