1) You are looking for a new hat	t! (E)->(In) <u>Are you looking for a new hat?</u>
2) The bunny is in his cage. (D)	-> (Im) _Put the bunny in the cage
3) Did the dog catch the stick? (In)-> (D) The dog caught the stick.
4) Sit on a chair. (Im)	-> (In) Can you sit on a chair?
5) We have all day. (D)	-> (E) We have all day!
