

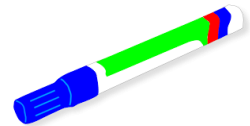
## Possessive Nouns – Using apostrophe + 's'

### Grade 1 Nouns Worksheet

Put an apostrophe + 's' after the noun.

*To indicate possession, put an apostrophe + 's' after the noun:  
The desk belongs to John;  
it is John's desk.*
