Grade 2 Capitalization Worksheet

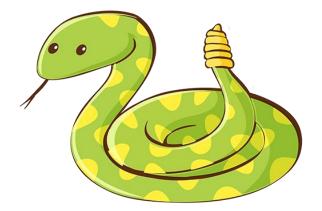
Rewrite each sentence and put commas where needed around the names.
