  Statement: <u>I can hula hoop for five minutes.</u>
  Question: <u>Can I hula hoop for five minutes?</u>
- Exclamation: My dad snores!
  Statement: <u>My dad snores.</u>
  Question: <u>Does my dad snore?</u>
- 4. **Question**: Do you like summer? Statement: <u>You like summer.</u> Exclamation: <u>You like summer!</u>
- 5. Statement: Centipedes can have more than 100 legs.
