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Answers

Answers will vary. Here are samples of possible answers.

- 1. You like reading. (*whenever*) You like reading **whenever** you have spare time.
- He is shorter than his brother. (*though*)
 He is shorter than his brother though he is older by two years.
- 3. This game is over. (*unless*) This game is over **unless** we score one more goal.
- 4. The movie will not start. (*until*) <u>The movie will not start **until** they close the entrance door.</u>
- 5. She plays basketball. (*whenever*) She plays basketball **whenever** she has the chance.
- 6. They ask for hamburgers. (*wherever*) <u>They ask for hamburgers</u> wherever they go for dinner.
