Underline the nouns and pronouns that each pronoun in bold refers to.

1. Martin, this is your mess. Clean it **yourself**!
2. I need a new pair of shoes. **Mine** are too small.
3. Paula made a card for her father. She colored it by **herself**.
4. It's time to go through your clothes. **Some** are too old.
5. Caleb and Cole have many stamps. They collected them **themselves**.
6. Count the scissors. It looks like **many** are missing.
7. Look at the candies in the store. **Those** look so good!
8. The artist painted a new painting. **It** is very lovely.
9. He invited all his cousins. Unfortunately, **few** can come.
10. Franklin showed us his pictures. He took them by **himself**.

A pronoun can refer to a noun or another pronoun.

*Luke and Alex washed the windows. They cleaned them all **themselves**.*

“Themselves” refers to the pronoun “They and the nouns “Luke and Alex”.
