## **Answers**

The United States of America is one of the four largest <u>countries</u> in the world. It includes a large <u>land</u> mass in the middle of North America, Alaska in the North West and Hawaii in the Pacific Ocean. The continental United States share a land <u>border</u> with Canada in the north and another land border with Mexico in the south. The country is surrounded by many bodies of <u>water</u>. In the east, the Atlantic Ocean touches the country. In the South, the Gulf of Mexico separates the United States from Cuba and other <u>islands</u>. The Pacific Ocean borders the west <u>coast</u> of the country. Around Alaska, in the west and the north, are the Bering Strait and the Arctic Ocean.

In the country, there are a variety of geographical <u>features</u>. There are coastal plains along the <u>shores</u>, rolling hills in the east, <u>mountains</u> in the west and several valleys and plains in the middle. Many <u>rivers</u>, like the Mississippi River, run through the country. About one-third of the US is covered in <u>forests</u> and about half of the country is used for agriculture. In some parts of the country, the land is dry and looks like a <u>desert</u>. Some places even have large canyons like the Grand Canyon. There are many interesting places to visit in this country.
