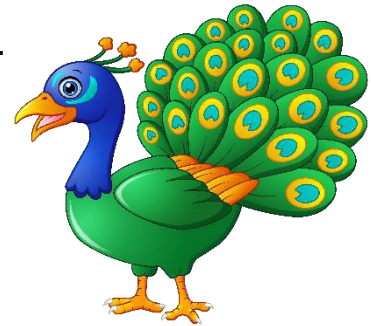
Grade 4 Sentences Worksheet
