Answer each question using **yes** or **no** as indicated. Restate the question in the answer.

**Yes** and **no** are always followed by **commas** at the start of a sentence.

No, he would not like to go to dinner tonight.	
Will we stop by the library on our way to the g	game? (yes)
Can we have cake for dessert? (no)	
Have we ever visited Seattle? (yes)	
Did she lose her phone? (no)	
Do you wake up early on the weekends? <i>(no</i>	)
Could you please pass me the salt? (yes)	
Is this your backpack? (yes)	



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## **Answers**

- Would he like to go to dinner tonight? (no)
   No, he would not like to go to dinner tonight.
- 2. Will we stop by the library on our way to the game? (yes)
  Yes, we will stop by the library on our way to the game.
- 3. Can we have cake for dessert? *(no)*No, we cannot have cake for dessert.
- 4. Have we ever visited Seattle? (yes)

  Yes, we have visited Seattle.
- 5. Did she lose her phone? *(no)*No, she didn't lose her phone.
- Do you wake up early on the weekends? (no)
   No, I do not wake up early on the weekends.
- 7. Could you please pass me the salt? (yes)
  Yes, I could pass you the salt.
- 8. Is this your backpack? (yes)
  Yes, this is my backpack.
