Grade 1 Word Problems Worksheet

George always takes care of the garden in front of his house.

- There are plants and trees in George's garden. There are 31 flowering plants, 6 vegetable plants and 2 trees. How many plants are there in the garden?
- 2. In his garden, there are 3 types of roses. He has 9 red rosebushes, 8 white rosebushes, and 4 yellow rosebushes. How many rosebushes are there in the garden?
- 3. George decides to make mango jam. He harvests 2 baskets of mangoes from the mango tree in his garden. Each basket holds 16 mangoes. How many mangoes does George harvest?



4. He ordered 15 plastic pots last week. A day later, he decided to get some indoor plants for his house, so he changed his order to add 7 ceramic pots and 2 bags of fertilizer. How many pots did he order in total?

5. George allowed his friend Ben to pick some flowers and vegetables from his garden. Ben picked 8 eggplants, 15 tomatoes and 4 sunflowers. How many vegetables did Ben pick?

6. Write the addition equation for this sentence: "George picked sunflowers from his garden to make 2 bouquets for his mother and sister. Each bouquet has 12 sunflowers. George picked 24 sunflowers."



Answers

- 1. 31 + 6 = 37There are 37 plants in George's garden.
- 2. 9 + 8 + 4 = 21There are 21 rosebushes in George's garden.
- 3. 16 + 16 = 32 George harvests 32 mangoes.
- 4. 15 + 7 = 22He ordered 22 pots in total.
- 5. 8 + 15 = 23
 Ben picked 23 vegetables from George's garden.
- 6. 12 + 12 = 24
