

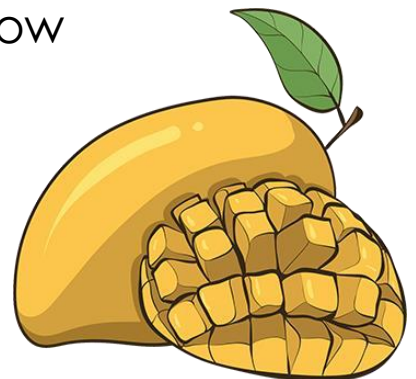
## Subtraction (single digits)

### Grade 1 Word Problems Worksheet

Fruit vendor Johnny works hard at his fruit stand every day.

1. Johnny had 7 oranges for sale at his fruit stand. Mrs. Carson bought 2 oranges. How many were left?
2. Johnny had 9 apples and 8 pineapples on display. One customer bought some apples, leaving 5 in the display. How many apples did the customer buy?
3. Jenny was amazed by the taste of the mangoes from Johnny's fruit stand. She bought 8 mangoes and gave 6 of them to her friend. How many mangoes did she have left?



4. Hans ordered 9 bunches of bananas from the fruit stand. Six of the bunches were good, but the rest were too ripe. He returned the too-ripe bunches to Johnny. How many bunches of bananas did Hans return?
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
5. Johnny ordered 7 bags of oranges and 4 boxes of grapes. He then sold 3 bags of oranges to his friend. How many bags of oranges did Johnny have left?
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
6. Write the following sentence as an equation:  
“There were 5 guavas displayed at the fruit stand. Mrs. Parker bought 3 pieces of guava fruit. There were 2 pieces left at the fruit stand.”

## Answers

1.  $7 - 2 = 5$

There were 5 oranges left in the fruit stand.

2.  $9 - 5 = 4$

The customer bought 4 apples.

3.  $8 - 6 = 2$

There were 2 mangoes left.

4.  $9 - 6 = 3$

There were 3 bunches of bananas returned.

5.  $7 - 3 = 4$

There were 4 bags of oranges left.

6.  $5 - 3 = 2$
