

Addition word problems

Grade 2 Word Problems Worksheet

1. Jovana filled her bucket with 115 pounds of shells. If she adds 112 more pounds of shell to fill her bucket, how many pounds does she have? Do you think she can pick up the bucket?

2. Lilly filled her bucket with 95 pounds of shells. If a friend comes to add 15 pounds of shells, and another friend comes to add 17 pounds of shells, how many pounds does she have altogether?

3. Isha's pencil is 12 cubes long. If she has two more pencils that are each 12 cubes long, how many cubes long are all three pencils together?



5. Isabella's hair is 18 inches long. If her hair grows 4 more inches each month, how long will it be in two more months?

Answers

1. $115 + 112 = 227$
She has 227 pounds of shells.
The bucket is too heavy to pick up!
2. $95 + 15 + 17 = 127$
She has 127 pounds of shells altogether.
3. $12 + 12 + 12 = 36$
The pencils are 36 cubes long.
4. $18 + 18 = 36$
Her hair is now 36 cubes long.
5. $18 + 4 + 4 = 26$
Her hair will be 26 inches long.
