

Mixed word problems – add / subtract / multiply

Grade 2 Word Problems Worksheet

1. There are 43 dogs, 72 fish, 34 cats and 2 trucks at my farm. How many pets do I have at my farm?

2. Kyle had 63 marbles but lost 12 of them. Lucy had 40 marbles then found 4 more. Who has more marbles?

3. Dane eats 3 cookies every day at lunch. How many cookies does he eat in 4 days?



4. Charlie has 31 more snowballs than Lucy. She has 19 snowballs. How many does Charlie have?
5. Josh had 60 apples. He had to give 2 apples to each student in his class. There were 20 students in his class. How many apples does he have after he gives away the apples?

Answers

- $43 + 72 + 34 = 149$
I have 149 pets at my farm.
- Kyle has $63 - 12 = 51$ marbles.
Lucy has $40 + 4 = 44$ marbles.
Kyle has more marbles.
- $3 \times 4 = 12$
Dane eats 12 cookies in 4 days.
- $31 + 19 = 50$
Charlie has 50 snowballs.
- $20 \times 2 = 40$
Josh is giving away 40 apples.
 $60 - 40 = 20$
Josh will have 20 apples left.
