Grade 2 Word Problems Worksheet

This year our school went to the zoo. The zookeepers were happy to welcome us.

 There were 23 girls and 18 boys on the bus. Together with the 2 teachers and the bus driver, how many people were on the bus?

2. There were many different fish in 2 ponds at the zoo. The first pond had 31 fish, and the second pond had 23 fish. Together with the 9 fish in the aquarium, how many fish were there at the zoo?

On the right-hand side of the zoo, there were 23 tigers, 12 elephants, 9 horses and 43 birds.
How many land animals were there?





4. In the central part of the zoo, there were 25 fourlegged animals, 9 two-legged animals and 12 animals with no legs. How many animals in the central part of the zoo had legs?

5. At the end of the day, the zoo cashier counted all the tickets sold. They had sold 23 adult tickets and 28 tickets for kids. Together with 2 tickets sold for senior citizens, how many tickets were sold altogether?

6. Write the addition equation for this sentence: In the zoo, an adult ticket is worth 14 dollars, while a kid's ticket is worth 8 dollars. If a family with 2 parents and 1 child went to the zoo, how much money would they spend on tickets?



Answers

- 1. 23 + 18 + 2 + 1 = 44There were 44 people on the bus.
- 2. 31 + 23 + 9 = 63There were 63 fish at the zoo.
- 3. 23 + 12 + 9 = 44There were 44 land animals.
- 4. 25 + 9 = 34There were 34 animals with legs.
- 5. 23 + 28 + 2 = 53There were 53 tickets sold.
- 6. 14 + 14 + 8 = 36 The family spent \$36 on tickets.
