### Grade 2 Word Problems Worksheet

Mr. Owen's classroom is the computer lab. All of his students are excited to come to his class.

1. There are 56 computers in the computer lab. 47 of them are being used by students. Mr. Owen is using one computer for his demo. How many computers are not being used?
  
2. There are supposed to be 32 students in Mr. Owen's class, but 3 of them didn't attend. How many students are present?
  
3. There are 61 monitors and 53 keyboards in the computer lab. 5 of the monitors are defective. How many monitors are working?



4. Mr. Owen expected to receive 32 projects from his class online yesterday. He only received 28 projects on time, and the rest were submitted late. How many projects were submitted late?
  
5. The school ordered 52 new computer mice and 12 new computer cameras. The supplier delivered 29 computer mice and 7 computer cameras. How many computer mice are needed to complete the order?
  
6. Write the subtraction equation that fits this sentence: "Mr. Owen gave a 50-question test to his class. Daniel got 39 points on the test. So, Daniel made 11 mistakes."

## Answers

- $56 - 47 - 1 = 8$   
8 computers are not being used.
- $32 - 3 = 29$   
29 students are present.
- $61 - 5 = 56$   
There are 56 working monitors.
- $32 - 28 = 4$   
There were 4 projects submitted late.
- $52 - 29 = 23$   
23 computer mice are needed to complete the order.
- $50 - 39 = 11$
