1. There are 261 fishbowls. Each fishbowl has 23 fish. How many fish are there?

2. We ordered 21 pizzas. Each pizza has 8 slices. How many slices of pizza are there altogether?

3. Chris gave his 35 friends 12 pieces of candy each. How many pieces of candy did Chris give his friends?



4. Emily collected eggs from the hen and put them into 303 baskets. She put 28 eggs into each basket. How many eggs did Emily collect?

5. There were 150 bookshelves. Each bookshelf had 15 books. How many books were on the shelves?

Answers

1. $261 \times 23 = 6,003$
There are 6,003 fish.
2. $21 \times 8 = 168$
There are 168 slices of pizza altogether.
3. $35 \times 12 = 420$
Chris gave his friends 420 pieces of candy.
4. $303 \times 28 = 8,484$
Emily collected 8,484 eggs.
5. $150 \times 15 = 2,250$
There were 2,250 books on the shelves.
