A <b>sequence</b> is what happens <i>first</i> , <i>next</i> , and <i>last</i> .	

Here are some examples. Write the number 1 in the box beside what happened first. Write the number 2 in the box beside what happens next. Write the number 3 in the box beside what happens last.

1. What happened tirst, next, and last?	1, 2, or 3?
Marco was ready for a snack.	
Marco decided to make a sandwich.	
Marco came home from school.	



2. What happened first, next, and last?	1, 2, or 3?
Marco put peanut butter and jelly between the bread slices.	
Marco took out two slices of bread.	
Marco enjoyed his sandwich.

3. Draw 3 pictures to show the **sequence** of how Marco made his snack. What did his sandwich look like *first*, *next*, and *last*?
