Liam and Jordan ran up beside him. "Nice hit!" Liam started to say, but then his eyes went wide.


Ethan followed his gaze. A long crack stretched across the kitchen window. No one said a word.

A car rumbled down the street. His ears perked up, and his tail thumped against the floor.


He stood up, watching out the window, but the car drove past. His tail stopped wagging. He let out a small whine and lay back down.

Top Two Clues in Text

Answers may include any of the following:

- Ethan stared at the house.
- <u>Liam said, "Nice</u> <u>hit!"</u>
- <u>There is a crack</u> <u>in the kitchen</u> <u>window.</u>
- <u>There is a baseball</u> on the ground below the window.

What I Know

Answers will vary.

The boys <u>broke</u> the kitchen window with a baseball.

Top Two Clues in Text

Answers may include any of the following:

- <u>Buddy sat by the</u> <u>front door.</u>
- <u>The big yellow</u> school bus came.
- <u>Buddy's tail starts</u> wagging.
- <u>Buddy could hear</u> <u>footsteps of someone</u> <u>walking up to the</u> <u>house.</u>
