Match each invertebrate to its classification.

<p><u>Mollusks</u> soft body with a shell</p>	 sea sponge
<p><u>Arthropods</u> exoskeleton and jointed legs</p>	 jellyfish
<p><u>Annelids (worms)</u> long, segmented body</p>	 snail
<p><u>Cnidaria</u> live in water, have stinging cells</p>	 cricket
<p><u>Echinoderms</u> live in water, radial symmetry, have spines or spiny skin</p>	 earthworm
<p><u>Porifera</u> spongy, live in water</p>	 sea star
