Sams forgotten his racket, so his dads bringing it from home.

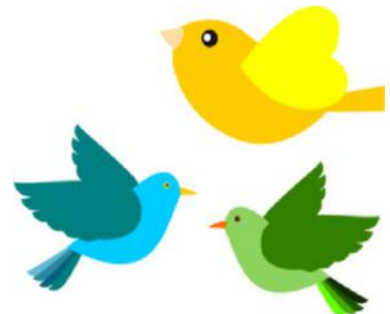
