The apostrophe has two functions.

1. To show possession/ownership. E.g. This is Ben's dog.
2. In contractions when a word or letter is missing. E.g. Don't go inside. (Do not)

It was somebody elses idea to move the sofa.

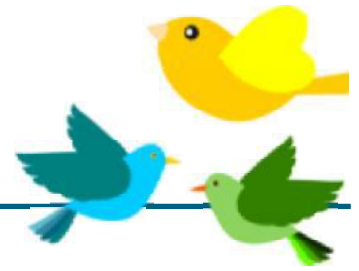
Kerrys been swimming since she was 3 years old.
