

## Words ending in -ing

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### First Grade Vocabulary Worksheet

Spelling rules for adding -ing:

- With a short vowel sound before the consonant, the final consonant is doubled, e.g. stopping.
- With a short vowel sound and two consonants, we add -ing, e.g. dressing.
- With a long vowel, we simply add -ing, e.g. barking.
- Words ending in e, we remove the letter -e and add -ing, e.g. living.
