**What is the root word? worth**

**worthy** good and deserving respect, praise (characterized by)

**unworthy** not deserving respect, praise (not/opposite)

**worthless** having no real value or use (without)

**What is the root word? break**

**breakable** capable of breaking or being broken easily (capable/given to)

**Breaking** separate or cause to separate into pieces (action/process)

**unbreakable** not liable to break or break easily (not/opposite)
