**What is the root word? photo (light)**

**photograph** a picture made by using a camera that records an image on a surface that is sensitive to light

**photocopier** a machine used to make photographic copies

**telephoto** a lens with a longer focal length than standard, giving a narrow field of view and a magnified image

**What is the root word? mono (one)**

**monologue** a long speech or reading given by a single speaker

**monotonous** not interesting because of having to do the same thing over and over

**monosyllable** a word of only one syllable

**What is the root word? mid (middle)**

**midfield** the area of a playing field in sports such as football or soccer about halfway between the goals

**midday** the middle part of the day

**midair** any location between very high and low in the air but well off the ground
