

Hook the reader: Questions

Grade 3 Writing Worksheet

A **hook** is an opening sentence that grabs the reader's attention so they want to keep reading. It "hooks" your reader!

An **interesting question** is a hook that sparks your reader's thinking and curiosity. For instance, a question hook for a paragraph about why pepperoni pizza is the best pizza might say: *Have you ever bitten into a just-out-of-the-oven piece of cheesy pepperoni pizza?*

Write a **question hook** for the topics below:

1. Watermelon is the best fruit.

2. Monkeys could make good pets.

3. It would make sense for more people to live in treehouses.

4. Dogs should be allowed in bed.
